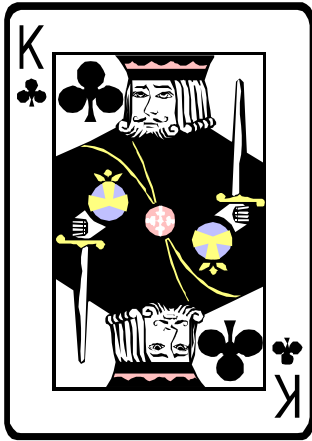

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ◆ The event will be run according to Speedway New Zealand Inc. Rule Book.
- ◆ All drivers must hold a current SNZ Licence and all vehicles must comply with the current Speedway New Zealand Rule book and supplementary regulations.
- ◆ A noise level of 95 dba will be enforced.
- ◆ Electronic lapscoreing will be used. Lapscoreing will be by way of the Dorian Date-1 Timing/Scoring system. The official transmitter for Electronic Lapscoreing is Dorian Data-1 TX8000 or Dorian Micro 2004
Vehicles without a transmitter will not be permitted to race.
- ◆ No duplicate numbers, locally contracted cars to retain numbers.
- ◆ It is a condition of entry that cars arrive for scrutineering displaying the number allocated to them by the West Coast Speedway Association on receipt of entry.
- ◆ Numbers must comply with SNZ ruling (no cardboard/paper duplicate numbers).
- ◆ The Promoter reserves the right to alter the format and closing date after consultation with officials, if deemed necessary. You will be notified of any such changes.
- ◆ No telephone entries will be accepted.
- ◆ Promoter reserves the right to limit fields on a 'first in' basis. There are maximum numbers for each class.
- ◆ In the event that you have already forwarded an entry form and you discover that you are unable to attend this meeting, you must notify the promoter as soon as possible.
- ◆ In the event of a rainout, the Promoter reserves the right to hold the event on the next most opportune day and time.
- ◆ Two people in each tow vehicle receive free entry into the track, if the driver of the race car does not come to the track in the tow vehicle, they must pay to enter.
- ◆ Prize money will be paid out at the prizegiving unless there is a protest. In that case it will be kept for ten days.
